# **Dehumidifier**



- 2. Check the water level regularly and empty as necessary.
- 3. Keep cables clear of any sharp edges in the work area.
- 4. If the cable appears to be cut or damaged in any way, switch off and unplug at the mains before inspecting it. If the cable attached to the dehumidifier is damaged, stop using the equipment. Contact the hire company. If an extension cable has been damaged, do not use it again.
- Do not restart the dehumidifier immediately after switching it off this can be 5. harmful to the equipment. Leave it for approx. 5 minutes before restarting.
- Take care not to accidently pull the plug from the socket. 6.
- 7. Switch off and remove the plug from the socket before carefully moving the unit.
- 8. Switch off and remove the plug when not using the unit.
- 9 If the equipment does not work properly do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire company.
